From the Board Meeting of: July 8, 2013

- 1. The Board approved the School District Achievement Contract for 2013-2014.
- 2. The Board accepted the School District/Community Literacy Plan Spring Update for 2013 from Barbara Maher, Fiona Clare and Kerry Milner Cairns. The report details the literacy initiatives in the communities of Kamloops, Chase, Logan Lake and Clearwater.
- 3. The Board received a report on the Foundation Skills Assessment results for 2013 from Assistant Superintendent deBruijn.
- 4. The Board referred the Annual Trustee Stipend Report to the Policy Committee.
- 5. The Vice Chair of the Board reported on the Canadian School Boards Association Conference held in Vancouver on July 4-7.
- 6. The Board received an update on development of the 2014-2017 School Calendar from the Education Committee.
- 7. The next regular public Board Meeting will occur on Monday, August 26, 2013, at the School Board Office, 1383 9th Avenue, Kamloops, BC.

- Ms. Acacia Schmietenknop and other representatives from the Enactus Thompson Rivers group at TRU described some programs that they offer for students in School District #73. Programs include environmental awareness and initiatives to support the Food Bank.
- 2. The Board approved April 7, 2014, as the "Day of Sucwentwecw" a day to acknowledge one another and recognize the history of the Secwepemc/Aboriginal people. The Day of Sucwentwecw has been endorsed by the First Nations Education Council and will include various activities including lesson plans and resources. The day will be followed by a ceremony involving the First Nations Education Council, First Nations and Aboriginal leaders, and Education Leaders from the District.
- The Board passed the Annual Facilities Grant (Revised) Project Bylaw.
